Texting	Voice Calls
More academic and professional for communication purposes	More of a layman's method of communication
Can be saved and documented for future reference	Cannot, unless the calls are recorded
Can be reviewed	Cannot, unless the calls are recorded, in which case they would require time to listen to the calls to review their content
Can form threads, which is very important in tracing the communication topic	Very difficult to thread
Can be checked for mistakes and errors, and this can increase their clarity	Cannot
Not used in cases of emergency	Used in cases of emergency (as when you call the police or an ambulance)
Not effective for illiterate individuals	Very effective for illiterate individuals
Not effective for argumentative debates and conferencing	Highly effective for argumentative debates and conferencing
